**To separate means to depart, detach, desist, pathways, unfollow...
→As a believer, you need the keys that enables you to Separate from the things of the world which tends to be corrupted. The Keys are the knowledge of God (Truth). This knowledge can be found in The word of God and the word is the standard for living the Christian life of Faith; faith comes by the word of God only.**

And be not fashioned according to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”*

Total Contentment

It is not always about your wants and selfishness, but you must learn to be not only **satisfied** but **happily satisfied** with the little in your hands God gave.

Philippians 4:11-12 ASV

“Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therein to be content. I know how to be abased, and I know also how to abound: in everything and in all things have I learned the secret both to be filled and to be hungry, both to abound and to be in want.”

Most Believers find it difficult to be contented with what they have. When you are unsatisfied you will go against the will or purposes of God in your life. Desires lead us astray most times. Lust are desires that drives us away from the spiritual things of God and it comes as a result of lack of contentment. *Romans 8:5* *“For they that are after the flesh mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.”*

Total contentment depends on the state of the Heart of a believer, So it is not about what you don't have, but what you have. There is a mentality to everything; just because someone says he cannot live without a car or any material thing, will you then follow him and what he says?.

=Don't allow the world dictate for, but allow the word which is of God rule you=

It is good to have good desires and ask, but first you must understand that God isn't interested in your request, rather in the fact that you have completed the quest of contentment successfully, and this can only be achieved when you have **patience with God**. *Ecclesiastes 5:10 ASV*

“He that loveth silver shall not be satisfied with silver; nor he that loveth abundance, with increase: this also is vanity.”

People sell their soul just because of the lack of contentment, but they fail to realize that this world is full of vanity: so when they collect the vanity of this world they lose the eternity of God. To separate your self from this world, you must learn to be contented with whatever you have, not allowing lust into your heart.

“My son, walk not thou in the way with them; Refrain thy foot from their path:”

Proverbs 1:15 ASV

If you're not contented, you will be influenced by people's lifestyle and you will eventually walk in the way with them. The dangerous thing about lack of contentment, is the fact that it drives you toward mischief, anger, greed, Complains, temptation, ambition... and many more that leads to sin. when what drives you is not of God, there will be total lack of contentment.

We as believers must not give in to the lack of contentment, so we could receive freely from God when we ask... Lets be desirous of the spiritual things of God; The Spiritual controls the Physical and if you are of the Spirit, you will be contented in the flesh. To walk in contentment is to be free from unsatisfying desires of the world.

Luke 16:10 ASV

“He that is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much: and he that is unrighteous in a very little is unrighteous also in much.”

When you are contented with the Little, you will be contented with the much- **This is the spirit that separates you from the ambition and dissatisfaction of the world.**

Total contentment is a vital key in the Christian race. Pick it up, run with it now!

Working Patience

Your walk with God requires the patience of God in you. To be hasty with God will make you far from God. Take patience as a personality, if it isn't active then it is not working. Your patience must be working in other for you to work closely with God.

“Behold, we call them blessed that endured: ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord, how that the Lord is full of pity, and merciful.”

James 5:11 ASV

Job had a working patience; that is why he didn't do as the world wanted him to do: He was different. Most times we lose our working patience because of the friends we pay attention to. We must learn to keep the patience personality close to us, not just because it's of God, but that **we learn more when we walk in patience**. In patience we see, discover, understand, progress, succeed and gain experiences.

In any situation you find yourself in, do not go with the hasty words of men but the calm words of God. If you keep listening to men, you gradually become impatient with God: Your patience will no longer be active (working).

A working patience requires an understanding spirit, one with the ability to **stand firm**. The Christian race requires patience, cause if you are not patient with God, you can't be patient with men.

“In your patience ye shall win your souls.”

Luke 21:19 ASV

To achieve certain things, you need your own patience not another's. The process of achieving is the passion in your working patience... This is why people invest money in patience, in other to make more money as time goes on.

A working patience will never find need to be hasty in life. **Patience separates you from hasty and impatient folks and it brings you to know God more.**

As believers we have the patience of Christ in us, because the trials of our faith which is in Christ, works patience and patience works experience which I call an acquired knowledge. This is that understanding of the spirit man that makes him prevail and end up successful in life.

“Therefore let us also, seeing we are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,” Hebrews 12:1 ASV

The race isn't ran in hast but in the understanding of patience in God. The product of Christ patience, proves the purpose of walking with God. No man can succeed without patience, it is a virtue.

“For ye have need of patience, that, having done the will of God, ye may receive the promise.”

Hebrews 10:36 ASV

“Here is the patience of the saints, they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.”

Revelation 14:12 ASV

The working patience of a believer is found in fulfilling the commandments of God and having faith in God. You will be separated from the world when you have a working patience...

Limiting Weakness

Every human being has a weakness and most times it is hidden. Just like in a battle, enemies seek each other's weaknesses and when you expose your weakness, you become vulnerable to attacks. So then weakness are covered with Strength so that the enemy never finds it.

“And he hath said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my power is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Wherefore I take pleasure in weaknesses, in injuries, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.” 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 ASV

=God's strength doesn't just cover but replaces a man's weakness=

Christ strength is found in a believer's weakness, this is because God's weakness is stronger than men's strength. God doesn't tempt a man, a man is tempted by the devil. =To Resist, you must Insist= You can overcome the devil when you are conscious of God's strength in your weakness. Understand that you have been test run by God to overcome, so the devil is always surprised when your weakness limits you as a Christian. Devil only fulfills the law of **Try an error** when he tempts your weakness. It is up to you to decide where you draw strength from. **God doesn't give strength to men of strength (who doesn't ask) but men of weakness (who asks)**. Do not hide your weakness, cause if you do, you won't find the strength in it, rather you will be foolish in depending on your own ability.

=An ability without God's capacity will tend to a disability= Do not be wise in your own eyes.

“but God chose the foolish things of the world, that he might put to shame them that are wise; and God chose the weak things of the world, that he might put to shame the things that are strong;”

1 Corinthians 1:27 ASV

“Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.” Matthew 26:41 ASV

To get strength form God, you must first withdraw yourself from the world in other To draw closer to God who has all the strength - This can be the act of seeking God through prayer: Jesus went to pray, because He needed to replace weakness with Strength *“the flesh is weak”*. The world will only make your weakness limit you, so you must be separated. Apart from Prayer, you draw strength from the things of God and this strength can be; Knowledge, wisdom, understanding, confidence, courage, trust... this is what enables one to watch (careful or conscious) as Jesus said. We must stay close to the things of God in other for us to withdrawing ourselves from the things of men.

When the strength of God is upon you, not even your weakness can limit you, this is because God's strength is beyond flesh, it is supernatural and is of the Spirit. So when you have the spiritual strength from God, you will be able to eliminate weakness that draws you closer to the world. The devil only tempts your weakness through the flesh lust and to resist him you must persist on getting the spiritual strength from God. **WATCH & PRAY!**

Depend on the Holy Spirit

“The Lord will deliver me from every evil work, and will save me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be the glory for ever and ever. Amen.”

2 Timothy 4:18 ASV

When you depend on the God you will be delivered from the things of the world. The Spirit of God is in you and you must learn to depend on him in order to be separated.

“who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us out of this present evil world, according to the will of our God and Father:”

Galatians 1:4 ASV

The will of God was the promise of God - *“I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh”* You have the Spirit so depend on the Spirit not on your own understanding. There are certain trials and temptation that requires the Spirit of God in order for you to be delivered. To be separated you need to depend on the deliverer inside you which is the Holy Spirit.

“And we are witnesses of these things; and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God hath given to them that obey him.” Acts 5:32 ASV

The Holy Spirit only comes on those that have the obedience of faith, that's why the Spirit is received by faith. When the obedience of faith is completed in you, there are works to show for it. James 2:17-Faith without works is dead. **Faith has principles which are the mystery of the kingdom of God.** *1 Timothy 3:9“holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience”*

The more faith you have the more confidence you gain towards the Holy Spirit in you. Faith is built by an understanding of the word of God. Through the Knowledge of God faith is built up and by understanding faith is established. *Proverbs 24:3-“Through wisdom is a house builded; And by understanding it is established;”* It is not just to have faith but to grow faith (keeping faith); this is the only way you can fully depend on the spirit of God and the only way you can be delivered from walking in the ways of men.

When you depend fully on God, you won't need to depend on men who will use you and may corrupt you. Relying on God is the only way you won't rely on men's corrupt mindset. When you trust in God, your mind will be zeroed down when the world tries to narrow your mind down to think like it. You can not depend on God in the wisdom of men (your own understanding) but in the knowledge of God (God's wisdom). *“Knowledge is Power”* Faith is kept by God's Knowledge in you.

“that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.”

1 Corinthians 2:5 ASV

Your faith growth is needed, cause without it, it is impossible to walk in the spirit. Having the spirit is different from being led by the spirit.

“If we live by the Spirit, by the Spirit let us also walk.”

Galatians 5:25 ASV

“But I say, Walk by the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.”

Galatians 5:16 ASV

Depend on the Holy Spirit by walking in the spirit and being led by the spirit.

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Wisdom To Respond

*Matthew 10:16 “Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore **wise as serpents**, and harmless as doves.”*

Most times to be separated from the world, we must possess the wisdom from God. The serpent is the most subtle animal and knows how to sense dangers. If we are not wise we will not be able to sense the dangers in the world. We need wisdom to respond to the responsibilities the world tries to create for us, that can make us equally yoked with it. This wisdom is needed in your conversations, attitude and responds towards men who walk in their own wisdom which is not of God.

“Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.”

Colossians 4:5 ASV

*“Look therefore carefully how ye walk, not as unwise, **but as wise**; redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Wherefore be ye not foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.”*

Ephesians 5:15-17 ASV

The devil uses men to draw men away from the things of God, but those that are wise can't be drawn away because they are careful enough to walk in the wisdom of God. This is how we take charge of the things that influences. This wisdom you need is not of men but of God, for men's wisdom are foolishness of the heart and it is of the flesh. James 3:15-“This wisdom is not a wisdom that cometh down from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.” God's wisdom is always heavenly.

Wisdom can be gotten from **understanding what the will of God is**. To get wisdom from God you must have an understand of God's will.

*“But if any of you lacketh wisdom, let him ask of God, who giveth to all liberally and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. **But let him ask in faith**, nothing doubting: for he that doubteth is like the surge of the sea driven by the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive anything of the Lord; a doubleminded man, unstable in all his ways.”*

James 1:5-8 ASV

Faith comes by hearing God's word, so faith is an understanding of the will of God. This is how you get wisdom from God. You must build up your faith to be established through and in the word of God. Separate your self from doubts. Seek the wisdom of God by understanding His will and not your will. The will of God are always good and not evil. Romans 12:21-“Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.” When you understand, your faith is established and you will have the wisdom to respond and overcome at all times. Many people can't respond because they lack understanding of the will of God. Responding tells the world that you know where you stand, your confidence, reasons, and perspective. Wisdom to respond separates you from taking, following and walking in men's own reasoning or mentality.

Wisdom is like a defense strategy that separates you from the world. It is possible for this defense strategy to grow and that depends on your understanding...

“Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom; Yea, with all thy getting get understanding.”

Proverbs 4:7 ASV

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
