To separate means to depart, detach, desist, pathways, unfollow...  $\rightarrow$ As a believer, you need the keys that enables you to Separate from the things of the world which tends to be corrupted. The Keys are the knowledge of God (Truth). This knowledge can be found in The word of God and the word is the standard for living the Christian life of Faith; faith comes by the word of God only.

And be not fashioned according to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God."

Romans 12:1-2 ASV

### Keys To Separate SET THE VISION Part1

PROVERBS 29:18 = Where there is no vision, the people perish...

Vision is a goal, target or plan which has a purpose. A vision is achieved when there is no loss of purpose.

"Jehovah of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely, as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, so shall it stand:" Isaiah 14:24

Thoughts formed vision and the act of walking towards a vision is called purpose. A vision can be set, but if the purpose isn't recognized, that vision remains a picture.

God designed man for His glory (vision). If a man walks out of God's Purpose, that man will be without the glory of God which is the vision. The Life of Christ that we live by, is one full of purpose and these purposes are known as callings.

"having the eyes of your heart enlightened, that ye may **know what is the hope of his calling**, what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints," Ephesians 1:18

"A man of vision listens to the calling and not the falling"

There must be an understanding of purpose before anyone can walk in a vision. To get the right understanding you must separate yourself from the wrong understanding. The people around you can influence your vision in a negative or positive 'A medical student who wants to do better, will hang way. around Doctors". The vision you set will determine the friends **you keep**. Never allow people draw you away from your calling. "Every purpose is established by counsel; And by wise guidance make The kind of friends you thou war. " Proverbs 20:18 keep will determine the kind of councils you receive. And when Purpose is diverted vision is lost. God wants every believer to separate from men that will hinder the purpose of which you exist. Learn to stay focused. "And even these reel with wine, and stagger with strong drink; the priest and the prophet reel with strong drink, they are swallowed up of wine, they stagger with strong drink; they err in

*vision, they stumble in judgment. Isaiah* 28:7. Vision can't be realized when Purpose is neutralized. To remain on the track of your vision, you must be discipline to stick to the purpose. Thereby you must separate yourself from the things that pull you out and make you lose focus from walking in the vision. People walk away from the principles of establishing their own visions, because they walk into the distractions; fulfilling other people's vision. Remember that purpose is the reason for vision and when there's no vision . At every stage of life, embrace the purpose...

# Keys To Separate <u>The Follower</u> Part2

Who you follow determines who follows you and what influences you will determine your influence on others. You must learn to follow the right people in life.

To follow is to imitate, copy or give close attention.

"Brethren, be ye imitators together of me, and mark them that so walk even as ye have us for an ensample." Philippians 3:17 ASV

The life of Christ is what every believer follows and this life is a life of goodworks through the spirit of God. This goodworks are seen in everyone that is Christ like. The patterns of your works can attract the right or wrong people to you...

*"in all things showing thyself an ensample of good works; in thy doctrine showing uncorruptness, gravity,"* Titus 2:7

*"Be ye imitators of me, even as I also am of Christ."* 1 Corinthians11:1 KJV: Be ye **followers** of me...

A follower is a learner, a servant, a believer, and has the spirit of faithfulness. God wants us to be followers of that which is good, pure, righteous and holy, just as Christ is. When you follow, you create a fellowship, and if the fellowship is of darkness, it separates you from the light of God. "*Be not unequally yoked with unbelievers: for what fellowship have righteousness and iniquity? or what communion hath light with darkness?*" 2Corinthians *6:14.* Let's learn to watch what we follow in our daily lives.

*"and have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather even reprove them;"* Ephesians 5:11

Our fellowship with God will show our works and our goodworks are the works of light.

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honorable, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of **good report**; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. The things which ye both learned and received and heard and saw in me, **these things do**: and the God of peace shall be with you." Philippians 4:8-9

Draw close to them that are of goodworks and followers of the right things. Pursue after the things of God and stay close to the light of God which will attract lights, and expose darkness.

To be separated from the world, you must learn to follow the children of God. Follow men who has God's word and that walks in the patterns of Christ Jesus.

# Keys To Separate Your Ways

"Look therefore carefully how ye walk, not as unwise, but as wise;" Ephesians 5:15 ASV

The way that seems right unto a man will end in destruction. God wants men to walk in His ways not in theirs. Your ways can be God's ways if only you choose to acknowledge God. "*Trust in Jehovah with all thy heart, And lean not upon thine own understanding: In all thy ways acknowledge him, And he will direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes; Fear Jehovah, and depart from evil:*" Proverbs 3:5-7

When you involve God, you become wise, but when you ignore you become unwise. Walking with God in your ways, he makes you become sensitive to the things of Him which are of the spiritua, and when you are spiritually minded, you won't walk in your own ways but in God ways.

=Your ways doesn't make you wise, but God makes you wise in your ways=

"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, But the end thereof are the ways of death." Proverbs 16:25 ASV

Be not wise in your eyes, be not proud, be not ignorant, be not smart in darkness, cause these can hinder relationship with God. Let your heart be opened towards God and let your ways be of God's ways and not of men. Be careful of what influences your ways in God. Learn to cutoff evil and vain communications.

"Be not deceived: Evil companionships corrupt good morals." I Corinthians 15:33 ASV

As believers, our ways are transformed into God's ways. So by faith we walk in God's ways because we acknowledge who we believe in and we refuse to walk in our own wisdom, but having full confidence and trust in God, that our ways are kept by Him. When a man lacks faith, he cannot acknowledge God and he will lack the wisdom and walk in the ways of men which is foolishness before God Almighty.

"But if any of you lacketh wisdom, let him ask of God, who giveth to all liberally and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. But let him ask in **faith**, nothing doubting: for he that doubteth is like the surge of the sea driven by the wind and tossed".

*"a doubleminded man, unstable in all his ways."* James 1:5-6, 8 Faith makes a man's ways to please God: Meaning that a man of faith has the knowledge of God in him, which are of good ways.

#### Keys To Separate

#### Kill Interest

Part4

"but each man is tempted, when he is drawn away by his own lust, and enticed." James 1:14 ASV

The devil can't get you if you aren't interested in his offers. Your heart is where temptation comes in and this temptation comes as a result of lust and desires. Lust is the cause of interest and the devil can only get your full attention when you are interested. The Heart is the battle field of desires and wants... which are results of one's interest. A man's heart is corrupted by lust when he allows it. We must learn to kill the Interest of the things of this world in other to be separated from this world.

"Wherefore God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts unto uncleanness, that their bodies should be dishonored among themselves: for that they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshipped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen."

Romans 1:24-25 ASV

When you are blinded by the Interest of your heart towards the temptation of the devil, you become of the world. The heart was created to be pure and you can't be pure when you give into lust. As a believer, you shouldn't hold the truth of God in unrighteousness; That is like having unclean in clean. Killing an

Interest over something may be difficult to some especially when the root is not uprooted.

To kill Interest, you must learn to be contented, patient and set your desires above only. Friends will not help you kill Interest, you have to do it yourself (Discipline), and when they know you aren't interested, they back of. This is how you separate yourself from friends who can't help you in positive way.

The act of discipline helps you kill Interest over anything not of God. Indiscipline will tell you that "it is easier said than done" But Discipline will tell you "it is easier done than said".

Discipline can be achieved when there's an understanding of purpose (the reason for discipline). Many can't kill Interest that's why they end up being addicts. Addiction doesn't start the first day, but rather it starts the day one becomes interested. To be free, you must learn to kill Interest without mercy by creating a standard for living. In Christ you will find the right standard to raise in life. Don't let Interest kill you first, KILL IT NOW!

#### Keys To Separate Benefits of following

*"And he saith unto them, Come ye after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Matthew 4:19 ASV Jesus turned fisher men into fishers of men.* 

These men abandoned the life they had just to create another. Note that they responded to a higher calling with a higher purpose "fishers of men" Before they followed, they had a strong conviction from God. so it wasn't their will but God's. When you follow a man with his benefits, you must have a conviction from God because not every man will give the right benefits. If there's no conviction the benefit may be negative. The knowledge, money or experience you get from following someone today may become a limitation to you tomorrow. You may not know the good or bad of things, but when you have a conviction from God, there's a level of confidence and assurance, that's why Peter and John didn't question God but followed God.

Ruth in the Bible had a strong conviction and followed Naomi and that is how she got the right benefits.(*see Ruth 1:10-17, 2:10, 4:13*).

Many people make the mistake of following the wrong persons and ending up with the wrong benefits.

To know the right people with the right benefits, you must be spiritually minded. *Those that are led by the spirit of Christ are sons of God.* It is through the spirit that you get the right conviction. Most times the devil brings his own conviction, but that conviction is of the flesh and it draws more to the things of the flesh which are fleshy lust. If the disciples had listened to their flesh, they wouldn't have followed God. *"because the mind of the flesh is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can it be: "* Romans 8:7. The spirit of God is sensitive to knowing the right people with the right benefits.

There are certain people you need in your life and there are certain people you don't need also; those with the right and wrong benefits. You must be spiritually sensitive to the benefits of having certain people in your life, you must be of the spirit to have a conviction from God: This is how you become sensitive to the right benefits. God's conviction is what will separate you from the world and the negative benefits of the world.
