SEASON 2: Works

Hebrews 10:20

INTRODUCTION: The process of being transformed is in the usefulness of information. You can only walk when you have the right information.

Knowledge is an information gotten that creates a difference. So walking in the Knowledge of God is of the process of divine transformation. The more you know about a particular thing the more understanding you have about that thing. Life is ruled by the understanding of the spiritual, and if you don't have that understanding, you can't walk in the spirit. That's why believers walk by the understanding of Faith which is of the spirit. **Faith is an expression of Christ's understanding.** A believer is saved by the knowledge of God through faith in Christ Jesus.

Walking in the new law of God is simply representing Christ through God's Knowledge in your life. In other words there is a new way which is in Christ Jesus and to walk in that new way, you need the knowledge of God which is in Christ Jesus.

“by the way which he dedicated for us, a new and living way, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;” Hebrews 10:20 ASV

“For ye were once darkness, but are now light in the Lord: walk as children of light” Ephesians 5:8 ASV

We therefore walk in the new law which is of the light of God. *“O house of Jacob, come ye, and let us walk in the light of Jehovah.”* Isaiah 2:5. This new law was given so that men will not have to walk in darkness anymore.

The Faith Campaigner will be teaching on walking in the new law of life in Christ. Remember that you can't walk unless you understand and you can't understand unless you keep increasing in knowledge; cause when you understand you will walk in the new law of Christ.

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SEASON 2: Works

The Righteous

PART 1

Righteousness is a journey for believers. It is dangerous for a righteous man to embark on the journey of unrighteousness.

“When the righteous turneth from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, he shall even die therein.” This tells us that the ways of the righteous tends to life and the things of light alone.

“In the way of righteousness is life; And in the pathway thereof there is no death.” Proverbs 12:28

The journey of righteousness is not by the works of doctrines or or any works, but by Faith and faith needs works in other for it to be alive. So then, we don't do works to become righteous, but rather we have been made righteous by faith to do works. “Faith without works is dead” -This means as believer faith pushes you to act, respond, believe, receive, testify, declare, pray, give, sow, love, discipline... and do many more, that is why **the righteous live by Faith thereby building the works of faith in God.**

As a righteous man, you are not meant to be ignorant of God's righteousness, thereby following men's righteousness. God's righteousness is what will keep you in the light, but Men's righteousness are full of selfish doctrines and doctrines that are not of God, and will keep you in darkness. it may seem good to the eyes of them that walk by sight and not by faith of Christ.

*“For being ignorant of **God's righteousness**, and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the **righteousness of God.**”* Romans 10:3 ASV

A believer must first understand that there's no law above the sacrifice of Jesus and so there is no other righteousness apart from the righteousness of God which should be in every believer.

*“But now apart from the law a **righteousness of God hath been manifested**, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; **even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ unto all them that believe; for there is no distinction;**”* Roman 3:21-22

To live by God's righteousness you must first believe to the point of receiving the faith of God which is of Christ. Walking by the law of faith is the journey of God's righteousness and there the glory of God is found. Build your works of Faith in God

“The hoary head is a crown of glory; It shall be found in the way of righteousness.” Proverbs 16:31 ASV

In The Beginning...

PART 2

God doesn't finish a thing He didn't start. You don't start something without God and later call God to finish it. What happens at every beginning matters to the story of every ending. "There will be no end without a beginning"

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

In every beginning, there's a foundation that is laid and when that foundation isn't strong, the building won't stand even when it is finished. You must learn to recognize your foundation in the beginning of every phase of your life. Do not take any thing for granted; the devil looks to use your ignorant mistakes against you. Walking with God in the beginnings and not at the later endings. God walked with His word in the beginning and so His words were the foundation He laid. **"The Word was with God"**

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." John 1:1. (see Palms 102:25-26)

"That which was from the beginning, that which we have heard, that which we have seen with our eyes, that which we beheld, and our hands handled, concerning the Word of life" 1 John 1:1 ASV

When something creates another thing, it means life has been given to that thing to function in its designed purpose. The Word gave life to the foundation *"The Word of life"*. What do you stand or walk with in the beginning of that goal, vision, decision, expectation, purpose, career, investment, production or establishment. "What you walk with in the beginning determines the quality of how you finish the end" God doesn't finish a thing He didn't start. *"If the foundation be destroyed what can the righteous do"* = As a believer, to avoid a faulty and weak foundation in the beginnings of anything, you must learn to acknowledge God Almighty. To acknowledge is to involve, make known, reason with, tell and seek God with the understanding of the spirit and not of the flesh.

"Trust in Jehovah with all thy heart, And lean not upon thine own understanding: In all thy ways acknowledge him, And he will direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5-6 ASV

You cannot acknowledge when you don't trust and you can't trust when you lean on your own understanding. Faith is an act of trusting God, so faith is an understanding from God. We must learn to build our faith lives, to lay strong foundations.

The Confidence Personality PART 3

“Cast not away therefore your boldness, which hath great recompense of reward.” Hebrews 10:35 ASV

There's no doubt, no fear, no uncertainties or unbeliefs in confidence: In this we walk boldly and we don't put trust, but we carry trust in God, we don't have confidence, but we are confidence ourself. so we can't fail or lose confidence... As believers we have this personality in us because of God's faith which is what we live by and this faith cannot fail.

“according to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord: in whom we have boldness and access in confidence through our faith of him.” Ephesians 3:11-12

The Faith of God is what keeps the confidence personality.

The spirit of Guilt which is of a hardened heart, can hinder the faith of God in a believer's life. The confidence personality is required to receive rewards from God. Guilty conscience is a sign of weakness that attracts fear, doubt and unbelief in the heart. A clean or clear conscience is free from guilts that creates an unclean hear, making it hardened and this heart cannot receive the HolySpirit. The HolySpirit communicates with the spirit in a man's Heart, that is why the voice of your spirit is your conscience. The conscience communicates to the body whenever it's ways doesn't please God, and we learn to cleanse and purify... When a man's spirit is full of guilt, he cannot access the faith of God. A new conviction of purity gives a man the confidence of faith in God. So one must have a guiltless conscience in other to carry the confidence personality of the faith of Christ.

“Hereby shall we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our heart before him: because if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, we have boldness toward God;”

1 John 3:19-21 ASV (See Hebrews 3:6-8)

To cleanse the conscience, one must learn to be of the truth, this means you must be willing to be obedient to the truth of God. When the truth of God is established, there's no conscience of sin which is unto guilt. So you must learn to live in truth at all times.

“Seeing ye have purified your souls in your obedience to the truth unto unfeigned love of the brethren, love one another from the heart fervently:” 1 Peter 1:22 (see Hebrews 10:26)

Walking In Truth

PART 4

To be built up by the law of truth, you must learn to allow truth become a part of you. When Truth's law is established in you, it makes you a doer of truth (consistently). *“For if any one is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a mirror: for he beholdeth himself, and goeth away, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.” James 1:23-24*

The knowledge of truth must be increased for a believer to keep walking in the ways of truth. A man must first receive and grow the knowledge of truth in him. *“who would have all men to be saved, and come to the knowledge of the truth.” 1 Timothy 2:4*

The knowledge of truth is gotten from the Holy Spirit. We receive the Holy Spirit, to walk in the way of truth which is the light of God, and light drives even the darkest darkness away.

“even the Spirit of truth: whom the world cannot receive; for it beholdeth him not, neither knoweth him: ye know him; for he abideth with you, and shall be in you.” John 14:17 ASV

As believers we are lead by God's spirit and so we have the spirit that teaches us the way of truth. *Act 5:32* “To walk with the spirit of truth, you must be willing to be obedient...

“And for this cause we also thank God without ceasing, that, when ye received from us the word of the message, even the word of God, ye accepted it not as the word of men, but, as it is in truth, the word of God, which also worketh in you that believe.”

1 Thessalonians 2:13 ASV

The Spirit of God delivers the message of God (truth) in the hearts of men. But for a man to constantly grow in truth, he must be willing to obey “not only hearers but doers of God's word”. The Holy Spirit is the carrier of God's word (truth), which is a light unto the believer's path.

“For it were better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after knowing it, to turn back from the holy commandment delivered unto them.” 2 Peter 2:21

It is dangerous to know truth and not follow it. God wants every believer to carry (obedient to) the truth in righteousness, because unrighteousness hinders, holds and delays the growth of truth in a believer's life. *Romans 1:18*

“For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hinder the truth in unrighteousness;”

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Conclusion: Your works will determine your rewards, so let your works come from the act of faith in God. God is Interested in you (heart) and your works in Him. Be steadfast and pray for God to lead you to do the right works. Remember that God keeps faith!
