ABOUT

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Wonder of God's Eternal Life

The Greek word translated as life in (John 1:4) is zoe:

Zoe refers to the uncreated, eternal life of God, the divine life uniquely possessed by God.

"These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have **eternal life**, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God."

1 John 5:13

When we think of eternal life, we must pay attention to the life of God; because eternal life is the expression of God's life (An

Everlasting life) - This has been the aim of God for Mankind since the beginning.

In the beginning man had no need to seek for the life of Yahweh, because man had access to the eternal life, which was the tree of Life in the midst of the garden of Eden. Man's access to eternity was covered by the atmosphere of divinity, so as long as man remained under the covering which was the atmosphere of God's glory, his connection to the tree of life was not yet severed.

When man was created, man had need to adapt to Heaven's perspective, in order to remain under the atmosphere, and that was the essence of God's visitation. The establishment of Heaven's perspective was

generally based on the encounters that Adam had with God, in other words; God was grooming Adam into His likeness, through Heavens perspective.

In other for God to create man in His likeness, there had to be a mutation. So Man mutated from God's genetic sequence and that sequence is God's image. .

Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image,...” *Genesis 1:26*

God's image is His form, appearance or nature. An image is the representation of the real - It is an expression of the original.

The word "image" is translated from the Hebrew word "**tselem**", and it means: shape, picture, figure, shadow or reflection.

"So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him (Man); male and female He created them." Genesis 1:27

"God is spirit..." John 4:24

God's image is His Spirit - So man was made a spirit being before he was established in a host. It is that genetic sequence that enables man carry the qualities of God (Being in the likeness of God) through God's guidance (teachings).

And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. Genesis 2:7

The breath of God merged the spirit into the body and that was the establishment of man's soul. The soul is the central processing unit where the mind of the spirit and the flesh battles. Man was originally designed to be spiritual alive, because when the spirit is alive, it is in total control of the soul.

Another name for Man is humankind. God mutated into two genetic sequence; male and female spirits - Man is an inherited transformation of God's DNA; a manifestation that came from God's gene. That's why Jesus came to restore and give us a permanent DNA, which cannot be lost and that's the image of God (The Spirit of God).

But you are not ruled by your sinful selves. You are ruled by the Spirit, if that Spirit of God really lives in you. But the person who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to Christ.

Romans 8:9

Knowing your origin matters a lot. We existed as spirits before we manifested. God had established our spirit right from the beginning. So by default we have the dominating spirit which is from God, but if we don't recognize this, we will continue to walk in ignorance.

“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.” Jeremiah 1:5

The Spirit of God created me, and the breath of the Almighty gave me life.

Job 33:4

The physical is an expression of the spiritual, that's why the spirit can survive without the body, but the body without the spirit is dead. The spiritual controls the physical.

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and **subdue** it; have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

Genesis 1:28

(See Genesis 5:2) & (see Mark 10:6)

Man must learn dominion in order to dominate. Dominion is an understanding of who you are "Just like a lion knows what he is; he remains the king of the jungle". In verse 26 of Genesis 1: God was making a plan for Mankind - And that is the Dominion mandate. So after Man was created, then in verse 28; God still had to make Man understand the efficacy of His plan "Dominion". Every instruction of God gives knowledge to man's potentials. This is how God intended to Cultivate Dominion mandate in Man. The likeness of God is the place where this Dominion mandate is understood and made manifest.

Then God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, **to be like us...**" *Genesis 1:26*

The essence of God's Spirit is for man to be in His likeness (exercising dominion power). Image differs from likeness, but it is the access to being in the likeness of God. it is the image that obliges God to give guidance to Man. That's why even after the fall of Man, God still searched and He is still looking for those, He will give guidance to, because He sees His image (His Spirit)...

The Hebrew name for likeness is "**demuth**" meaning to be like something (Having the qualities; personality and mentality of something).

The Life of God expresses qualities - To have the life of God is to be in the likeness of God 'knowing the ways and the will of God'

"I said, "You are gods, And all of you are children of the Most High." **Psalms 82:6**

The image of God comes with an understanding of the Glory of God. Man was created in the glory of God, but man ignored that understanding, that's why man fell through disobedience to God. The fall of man is linked to Man's failure of understanding the Glory of God. Man was created for the glory of God and the understanding of this, keeps one in the consciousness of the Image (Spirit)...

Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have **created for My glory**; I have formed him, yes, I have made him."

Isaiah 43:7

The Image of God is God's Spirit and it carries the understanding of the glory. If you cannot reverence Him (The Spirit), you cannot remain under the covering His glory.

"And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him." Acts 5:32

Your obedience is an expression of your honor to God. It is one of the symbols of reverencing God in your life. Failure to obey is the inability to submit to the Lordship of Christ.

Since we respected our earthly fathers who disciplined us, shouldn't we submit even more to the discipline of the Father of our spirits, and **live forever?**

Hebrews 12:9

Until your obedience is full you can't experience the life of God and if you don't have the life of God, you cannot come to the understanding of Dominion mandate. Dominion mandate is the wonder of Eternal Life.

Obedience is the act of submission that pulls you out of the realm of ignorance. Obedience is how you learn to walk in the Spirit. So until you are submissive to the leading of the Spirit, your obedience can't be full.

It is an error for one to claim to have God's Spirit and be far from God's qualities (Fruits of the Spirit). When we walk in the Spirit we produce fruits that symbolizes the qualities

of God. If we have God's image, let's also learn to walk in God's likeness.

"If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit." Galatians 5:25

But the Spirit produces the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,...Galatians 5:22

The essence of having these qualities, is to make sure that you are on the right path to eternal life, in other words; having the Spirit of God, you need to walk in the Spirit in order to inhabit God's qualities. Walking in the spirit is the sense of obeying the Holy Spirit.

Since the spiritual controls the physical, the Spirit man was originally created to

have dominion over the affairs of the physical realm. This dominion is accomplished when a man's spirit is **awake, aware and alert of spiritual activities** in the kingdom. So we say that eternal life which is the life of God, is experienced only when the consciousness of the Spirit-man is alive (**awake, aware and alert**). Walking in the Spirit is an evidence of spiritual awokeness, awareness and alertness.

The Bible says when we walk in the spirit, we will not fulfil the lust of the flesh. (*See Galatians 5:16&19*). When the spirit-man is alive, one will not fall into the temptation of sin, because it is the spirit that quicketh.

Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame.

I Corinthians 15:34

Being Spiritually awake is the first step of being aware of Spiritual activities and when you are aware, the HolySpirit is obliged to make you alert, in other words; ready to react to every situation that arises in life. This is the bases of how the knowledge of God is established in a Man.

The HolySpirit is the one that quickens the spirit-man through the knowledge of God, so that the mortal body is constrained. If the spirit-man lacks the knowledge of God, the knowledge of sin will control the affairs of the soul. The knowledge of God keeps

the Spirit man alert. The knowledge of sin was a result of the fall of Man.

Then the serpent said to the woman, “You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.”

Genesis 3:4-5

Adam and Eve where deceived, because they had not fully grown into understanding God's personality which is Heaven's perspective. Their souls where exposed to the knowledge of Sin and because of that, the knowledge of God which was already there was severed.

The soul is a vessel that inhabits and processes knowledge. Man's soul was established according to the knowledge of God in the beginning. So man could reason through the mind of God, and by that, nothing ill could be found or formed in man. The fall of Man caused everything to change. The knowledge of sin came in through disobedience and It created a war between the knowledge of the spirit and the flesh (carnal man).

Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul

I Peter 2:11

I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh

lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

Galatians 5:16-17

Jesus came with the knowledge of God, to give us freedom from the bondage of sin or knowledge of sin. The knowledge of God will keep our spirits alive, whenever we continuously feed our souls with the Word of God. This has the ability to keep us in koinonia with God. We are sanctified by the Word and the Word contains the experiences, that houses the knowledge of God.

“They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **Sanctify** them in the truth; your **word** is truth.”

John 17:16-17

Jesus said to the people who believed in him, “You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings. **And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.**” **John 8:31-32**

The knowledge of truth is the knowledge of God and to acquire it, you must yield to it. Only a yielded man can understand the principles of the Spirit of Liberty.

always learning yet never able to come to the knowledge of truth.

2 Timothy 3:7

You don't learn it, you yield to it. Yielding talks about being a hearer and a doer. The freedom of the soul is dependent on how much knowledge of truth is established in a man.

But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

James 1:25

Man was born into the nature of sin by default of the knowledge that governs the world (Carnality), and the heart of man naturally aligns to the knowledge that governs this world. The revival of the knowledge of God, gives us the power to become instruments of God's righteousness

- By that, we walk according to the knowledge of the Spirit.

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:1

The knowledge of the God is also known as the Knowledge of the Spirit. The knowledge of the Spirit, is the recommendation for embracing liberty in the kingdom - being free from the condemnation of the knowledge of the flesh.

This introduces us to the Law of the Spirit of Liberty. Having brought to light the hidden agendas of the mind of God, in

other words; God's plan for Man is brought to light by the law of the Spirit of liberty. This law is part of God's guidance for us to be in His likeness.

Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

II Corinthians 3:17

The Holy Spirit feeds the knowledge of God to the soul (CPU) - this is the place where conviction takes place. It is the Spirit of God that gives the revelation of the Word, and that is how the knowledge of God is birthed in a man, then salvation is realized and the soul is won by the continuous feeding (renewing of the mind), so that the carnal man has no control...

Through Jesus, we have been given another chance, to grow in the knowledge of God which is the knowledge of the spirit, so that our souls will be kept to God. Man was created with eternity perspective in mind and for that perspective to remain, man must grow in the knowledge of God.

that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every **good work** and **increasing in the knowledge of God**;

Colossians 1:10

Jesus came so we would be born again - having a new spirit that is alive unto righteousness. The Spirit emits Life, in other words it has the ability to sustain the life of

God (eternal life) in a man - That's the essence of the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

"And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the **Spirit is life** because of righteousness."

Romans 8:10

The more you yield to the Spirit of life, the more you become an expression of God's life. When one is Spiritually minded, he/she experiences the life of God. Your obedience to the Spirit is dependent on how spiritually minded you are.

"For to be carnally minded is death, but to be **spiritually minded is life and peace.**" **Romans 8:6**

The Life and peace of God is how you keep the balance of your Christianity. Everything that pertains to life and peace is the symbol of the Spirit of Christ. If there is no life and peace in you, you will find it difficult following the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

The Life of God is found in the Son of God "Jesus Christ". Jesus showed us the wonders of eternal life through His own life.

"And this is the testimony: that God has given us **eternal life**, and **this life is in His Son.**" *1 John 5:11*

Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path. *Psalms 119:105*

The word is the light that directs you into the life of Yahweh. So if you have the life of

God, you automatically have the light of God in you. Once you have eternal life, your life should be an expression of light.

"In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it." *John 1:4-5*

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the **light of life.**"

John 8:12

For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

Psalms 36:9

The more life in you, the more your light keeps shining. In the kingdom the phenomenon of life is light. So the features of God's light causes an illumination and revelation of the path that leads to godliness.

The Word is life and it has the ability to transform one into a light. That's how the products of light (fruits of the spirit), becomes a comprehensive part of you as a believer.

"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 10:10

Jesus came so we could have light and have it more abundantly through His life.

You becoming a shining light is dependent on your ability to manifest products of light; In other words your lifestyle must be patterned according to the things which pertain to God's light and that is the existence of godliness. So then, it is the godliness behind your works that makes you a shining light and not just a light.

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

(Matthew 5:16).

Jesus was trying to explain eternal life as the life of goodworks, because goodworks

are the products of godliness. So This means; what inspires your light is the godliness behind your goodworks.

that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, *Philippians 2:15*

The Life of God and the Peace of God works together to grow your Spiritual sensitivity (awakeness, awareness and alertness). The kingdom priorities are recognized by your Spiritual senses (sensitivity). If you hold on to the life and peace of God which has the capacity to maintain your spiritual stability, then you will know the ways of God and will of God.

Just as godliness tends to God's life so also God's peace tends to contentment, forgiveness, the joy of the Spirit,... So godliness and contentment is where your spirituality brings you to maturity.

"Now godliness with contentment is great gain". *1 Timothy 6:6*

The great gain is the excellence of your spirituality. We have looked at one aspect of spiritual stability which is Life (the life of Christ), let us look at peace (the peace of Christ) which is the second aspect.

Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. *John 14:27*

"And the **peace of God**, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." **Philippians 4:7**

The peace of God is not like the peace of this world. It is not based on a system that can fail - And that's why He's reconciliation with man through Jesus is everlasting. God's peace is aimed at enabling a man guard his heart from the issues of life to the priorities of the kingdom. Most decisions men take are influenced by the state of their heart.

Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.

Proverbs 4:23

So, even while we seek godliness, our hearts must be ruled by the peace of God.

In order for our hearts to align, we must learn to submit our decisions to God for evaluation.

“Submit to God, and you will have peace; then things will go well for you”.

Job 22:21

To have the understanding that the peace of God gives, you must learn to submit every situation to God.

The peace of God gives a sound mind. Eternal life isn't a life of fear but a life of Faith. So then, Faith thrives on the ground of sound mind. The peace of God is a Faith booster when it rules your heart.

The Bible says; Faith without works is dead. Faith is of the Spirit. God ordained

man to walk in the understanding of Faith, but until a man submits to God, his works remains driven by the understanding of the flesh. Your good works should be an understanding of your Faith level. Faith grows in an atmosphere of peace. We where created for Faith works.

"For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them." *Ephesians 2:10*

"They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, **disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.**" *Titus 1:16*

Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit (the Spirit of Faith) and He went about

doing good (e Works of Faith). Good works are the manifestations and operations of the Holy Spirit. God leads us through our obedience to His Spirit, and the Holy Spirit shows us the patterns of goodworks through godliness.

"This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who have believed in God should **be careful to maintain good works**. These things are good and profitable to men." *Titus 3:8*

Eternal life is the life of God and the life of God radiates a godly lifestyle. The law of liberty recognizes the place of godliness.

The Spirit of life and the Spirit of peace forms the characteristics of a spiritually

minded man and only this kind of a man can effectively walk, follow, obey and listen to the Spirit of God.

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

Romans 8:16

It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.

John 6:63

(The word I told you are Spirit, and they give life.)

The Holy Spirit keeps the peace of God in our hearts. So in whatever we do, we will have the understanding of God's peace when we depend fully on the Holy Spirit.

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. **Romans 8:10-11**

You have the Life of God because of the indwelling of His Spirit in you. The Spirit is what Jesus was anointed with and it is same Spirit that Jesus sent as a comforter, helper, teacher, provider, an advocate and many more to us.

For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself,. **John 5:26**

The understanding of who Jesus is, creates the believe system that activates your spirit man. This is what the revelational

knowledge of Christ does to every individual. You can't inhabit the Spirit of God if there's no revelational knowledge. Jesus is the only one that has the Spirit that can give life. This Spirit, you received when you became born again (coming to the understanding of who Christ is) - A new spirit through the Spirit of Christ.

The Purpose of Eternal Life is in the essential expression of the Lamb Slain (The blood shed). The Spirit reveals the purpose of God's life in Man.

to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, **according to the eternal**

purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, *Ephesians 3:10-11*

The Purpose of Eternal Life

Eternal life is the life in Christ Jesus and Jesus laid down that life, for you and I to have it as a gift from the Father. This is the essential expression of the lamb slain - To receive that which pertains to life and peace.

saying with a loud voice: **“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive POWER and RICHES and WISDOM, And STRENGTH and HONOR and GLORY and BLESSING!”**

Revelation 5:12

The Eternal Life of -----

Power: -----

Through Christ we received dominion power. Power is the ability to exert potency or influence over something. Without power, believers cannot exercise supremacy (authority), over all things under God. In God's kingdom power helps us walk in the supernatural; Doing that which is beyond human capacity. Power always has a source and the source will determine the rank of power (Authority).

But you shall receive **power** when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8

The Spirit of God is the authority we carry on earth - He is the source. The consciousness of the Holy Spirit, brings us to experience the dominion power hidden in Christ. That consciousness is built by fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit frequently.

But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit,. Jude 1:20

The more we learn to synchronize with the Holy Spirit, the more we become

power proves. Power is utilized through Faith, so Faith produce results when it is built up in the understanding of God's power. That's why it is the most important of God's armour.

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, that your **faith** should not be in the wisdom of men but in the **power of God**.

I Corinthians 2:4-5

The criteria for an effective faith life is your dependent on your communion with the Spirit of Christ. The power of

God is Christ and Christ is an expression of the Word (*The Word made flesh*).

but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, **Christ the power of God** and the wisdom of God.

1 Corinthians 1:23-24

Our Faith must rely on the knowledge of Christ (The Word). The knowledge of Christ makes the power of God work in us.

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

Ephesians 3:20

So by the authority of Yahweh, we can exercise the power of the Spirit. Jesus had the power of the Spirit after He overcame the temptation of the devil. The more we submit to Yahweh in the place of fasting (watching) and prayer, the more we grow in the findings of His power (The Spirit), Which makes us overcomers.

Then Jesus returned in **the power of the Spirit** to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region.

Luke 4:14

The bible says: Submit your self under the mighty hand of God; resist the devil and he will flee. - Power comes when we submit to God in our secret place.

Submitting exposes us to the knowledge of Christ.

That the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know...., what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power.

Ephesians 1:18-19

The Eternal life of

Riches:

*I will give you the treasures of
darkness And hidden riches of*

secret places, That you may know that I, the Lord, Who call you by your name, Am the God of Israel.

The place of Riches cannot be neglected when it comes to having the life of God. There are certain principles, that governs the eternal life of riches. These principles where tested by some great men in the bible and they had increasing wealth. The foundation for these principles is seeking first the kingdom of God. (See *Matthew 6:33*)

The First is the Principle of Diligence: A man that is diligent is focused, willing and responsible. **Seest thou a man**

diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men. **Proverbs 22:29**

The Second is the principle of

Selflessness: The ability of one to think of the benefit of others - This principle understands the need to meet people's need. It recognizes the law of sowing and reaping. This is the attribute of every helper, giver and adviser in the kingdom of God.

The Third is the Principle of Integrity:

The integrity of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.

Proverbs 11:3. The word integrity has lots of values attached to it, but in this context; it talks about commitment to doing, keeping and following the right thing or the right way - leaving behind a pattern that is not compromised. "The integrity of your works".

After Adonai had spoken these words to Job, Adonai said to Eliphaz the Temanite, "My anger is kindled against you and against your two friends, **because you have not spoken about Me what is right, like My servant Job has.** So Adonai restored what Job had lost, after he prayed for his friends and **Adonai doubled everything that Job had before.** **Job 42:7, 10**

Then God said to Solomon: “Because this was in your heart, and **you have not asked riches or wealth** or honor or the life of your enemies, nor have you asked long life—**but have asked wisdom and knowledge for yourself, that you may judge My people over whom I have made you king—wisdom and knowledge are granted to you; and I will give you riches and wealth and honor, such as none of the kings have had who were before you, nor shall any after you have the like.”** **II Chronicles 1:11-12**

The Secret to accessing divine wealth is seeking the kingdom's interest. One similarity between Job and Solomon is that they had God or the things of God in mind.

So their decisions were not influenced by their circumstances or greed, but by the kingdom's interest (God's Interest).

Job maintained his integrity and Solomon was selfless in his request to God.

When a man follows these principles on the foundation of kingdom priorities at heart, God gives him/her the power to make wealth. Your goal should not be on making the riches but making the kingdom stand out.

Do not trust in force. Stealing is of no use. Even if you gain more riches, don't put your trust in them. Psalms 62:10

A man who depends on riches can never reach God. The first thing that is required is

your depends on God, and not your trust in riches.

Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

I Timothy 6:17-19

The Eternal life of Wisdom:

So be very careful how you live. Do not live like those who are not wise, but **live wisely**.

Ephesians 5:15

There's a necessity, for we as believers to have the life of Wisdom. Where there is wisdom there's freedom (freedom from the foolishness of men). Wisdom is the principal key for kingdom business. The wisdom of God has qualities that defines a man's life.

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. **James 3:17**

All these tends to show the prove of wisdom. God require you to acquire

wisdom; not only by searching wisdom but asking for it.

But if any of you needs wisdom, you should ask God for it. He is generous to everyone and will give you wisdom without criticizing you. But when you ask God, you must believe and not doubt. Anyone who doubts is like a wave in the sea, blown up and down by the wind.

James 1:5-6

Therefore, your Faith in God's Wisdom will determine your life of Wisdom. If you have doubts you cannot come under the umbrella of God's divine wisdom. Faith without works is dead, and so the application of God's Wisdom which is by Faith, requires your works. Works actually

proves your adherence to God's instructions (ways). (*See proverbs 15:33*)

If you are wise and understand God's ways, prove it by living an honorable life, doing good works with the humility that comes from wisdom.

James 3:13

The Eternal life of Strength:

And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

II Corinthians 12:9

The Latin word for Strength is **Viribus** - meaning; power, might, force or authority. There are certain situations we come across in life, that requires the divinity of strength in order to pull through. To receive this strength you must know the source. Until you know the source of strength, you cannot draw strength. It is the divinity of strength that defines your reality. Christ is the source of strength and our connection to Christ is His Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the one that transmits divine strength to us and that's the quickening of our mortal bodies.

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. **Philippians 4:13**

Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always. **1 Chronicles 16:11**

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Ephesians 6:10

Until you look to the Holy Spirit, you cannot walk in divine strength. Seek and you will find. Looking unto the Lord is the sense of being strong in the lord and that is being strong in the Spirit. So until you are strong (confident) in the lord, you cannot be endowed with **Viribus**. Whenever the Lord wants to strengthen a man He sends His Spirit.

This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel: **‘Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,’ says the Lord Almighty.**

Zechariah 4:6

The practical manifestation of divine strength is the Joy of the Lord - That's the Joy of the Spirit. When you put your trust in the lord, you will understand the essence of the joy that comes from the Spirit. This joy is not human standard but kingdom standard, and by so, it cannot fail. (See Isaiah 12:2-3)

...The Joy of the Lord is my strength.

Nehemiah 8:10

Those who listen to instruction will prosper;
those who trust the Lord will be joyful.

Proverbs 16:20

The manifestation of the Joy of the Spirit depends on your connection with the Spirit,

and your trust determines your connection to the Spirit of Christ.

He gives power to the weak, And to those who have no might He increases strength.

But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint.

Isaiah 40:29, 31

It remains clear that one must grow in the level of trust (dependency), he/she has in God in order to receive strength from God.

The Eternal life of Honour:

To live a life of Honour you must be vindicated for honour. The eternal life of honour is based on the foundation of humility. This foundation determines your vindication.

The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility.

Proverbs 15:33

When God finds the system of humility in a man, He tends to favour that man. Honour brings about favour, so when you learn to honour God by creating a system of humility, God tends to honour you by a system of divine favour.. It is not about how valuable you are but how honourable you are in God's sight.

But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. **II Timothy 2:20**

To be a vessel unto honour, you must understand the importance of humility; Submitting yourself to God's ordinance; Making yourself available and useful to God. A life of honour is established on a ground of purity. The more humble you are the more honour you get from God.

Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.

II Timothy 2:21

The Eternal life of Glory.

Bring all who claim me as their God, for I have made them for my glory. It was I who created them.'". **Isaiah 43:7**

The eternal life of glory is the glory of God on a man. When the glory of God comes upon you, you become an expression of the Glory - Reason being that you were made to be the house of God's glory; a channel that transmits the divinity of God's atmosphere. There are Possibilities that abound, under this God's atmosphere and they show the level of one's value in and to the kingdom. To become a perfect medium of God's glory, you must learn to become a

true disciple; A follower of Christ's patterns (works).

When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father. **John 15:8**

being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. **Philippians 1:11**

The evidence of a true disciple is by how much fruits he/she produces. When fruits are produced, glory is manifested and one becomes a carry of glory. The Glory causes an influence that shapens a man's life to be a light that shines.

Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you.

Isaiah 60:1

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 5:16

Your goodworks are the evidences that you are a house that emits the glory of God, In other words; God's splendor, beauty and power. By this you become a light in the world.

For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But **the Lord will arise over you, And His glory**

will be seen upon you. The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising. **Isaiah 60:2-3**

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. **Ephesians 2:10**

As a believer your works produces results (fruits), which showcases the Glory of Yahweh upon you. For you to carry God's glory your integrity must be tested and trusted, because God doesn't share His glory with man. You are meant to be a channel that men will watch and glorify God.

F.C.H Conclusion:

So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is **eternal**. 2 Corinthians 4:18

The Eternal life of God speaks of the Testimony of Jesus. So we set our eyes on the testimonies of Jesus, hidden in the purpose of eternal life and this is the essential expression of the Lamb Slain. Therefore we must learn to be carriers of the kingdom testimony (The good news), as an evidence in our christian race.
