•The Righteous Patience

Hebrews 10:36

For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.

The righteous patience must come in the similitude of the kingdom's integrity. This means, that patience is not a license to go out of the construct of God's will. Integrity before God is powerful; it talks about uprightness, steadfastness. It has the mind of faithfulness, consistency, diligence and It tends to fulfill the purposes, of the righteous patience; because it acts as a direction, in the time that a man's faith is being tried.

Proverbs 11:3

The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but

the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them.

Integrity is a guiding factor and one must learn to subscribe to it in the kingdom. Know that your works of patience, tends towards upholding a pattern of an integrity before divinity, only if it recognizes the will of divinity. This means, that the decisions you make or take in being patient, will be a reflection of how much integrity you have before God. So if what you do while waiting on God is not in line with God, you are wasting your time.

James 1:3-4

Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.

But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

Until patience have her perfect work in you, it will be difficult to resist the leading of your flesh desires. So it is of necessity that one learns the way of patience in God. There is a reason why Jesus said; in your patience possess ye your

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souls (*See Luke 21:19*).

Psalms 37:7

Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass.

To imbibe the spirit of patience, you need to synchronize with the spirit of peace. Yes! You need to have the understanding of the peace of God. It is in the atmosphere of an inward peace that one comes to full realization on resisting the flesh desires; especially the kind of desires that can drive you out of the will of God. So the essence of peace is to keep your heart and mind (patience) in God.

Philippians 4:7

And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

- **The Promises of Righteousness**

Hebrews 6:12

That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

It is possible for a man to run the christian race without receiving the promises (*see Hebrews 11:13*). You must understand that, the promises are found in the reality of Christ in you. It is a generational transfer of God's Will over the lives of the believers. So the reality of Christ begins with knowing the Spirit of Christ.

Acts 2:38-40

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and **ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.**

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

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And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward **generation**.

There's a promise that steps down the other promises, so it becomes accessible to men. The Holy Spirit is that promise that leads us to the reality of the promises. In other words he acts as a step down transformer which allows for the utilization of the amount of power that won't destroy a believer. That is why even if one desires to have all resources, he has to grow his faith from one level to another. This talks about management. You can't receive the fullness of the promises if you are careless about building your faith. In other words, you must learn the system of faith management, so that you don't begin to eat your future with the hope of a future. So like I said, without Him it is impossible to receive the promises. This why *Hebrews 11:13* talks about the people of faith that didn't receive the promises. Because the Holy Spirit had not be given at that dispensation.

Romans 4:16

Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

The assurance (seal) of the promise (HolySpirit) was appointed for a time when there will be an outpouring (manifestation of the promise). So until Jesus ascended, the promise remained pending. So the Holy Spirit is a replica of the personality of Jesus; to the intent that He may reach the hearts of all men.

The law isn't against the promises, but it has no power over the promises. Receiving the Holy Spirit is the key to accessing all the promises of God.

Hebrews 11:39

And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise (The Holy Spirit).

2 Corinthians 1:20

For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

• Righteousness Evidence

Romans 4:13

For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.

In righteousness evidence we are talking about proof producers. Righteousness is by Faith; This means that any righteousness that has no faith is not qualified to be reckoned with Christ. So If there's no faith factor there can be no proof factor.

Note; Your sacrifice, kindness and labour of love must be with the understanding of faith. Because this is how we fully accomplish God's righteousness.

Righteousness evidence are the works of faith or the works produced by Faith. (*Hebrews 11:1*) Faith is the evidence of the unseen. So for faith to operate, you must be seeing something in the spirit. And then your spiritual sight propels your works (actions), which will definitely tend to show righteousness. So being proof producers is by bringing to reality what we see and perceive in the spirit. It is not forced, it is not compelled, no pressure, it is just the power of free will, backed by an understanding of the Spirit. Once there is a contradiction, doubt, disbelief, then righteousness evidence will be tampered with. And this why we see believers give their time but they don't become intentional enough to be proof producers. Being a proof producer requires a consistent amount of energy.

Hebrews 11:33-36,39

Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

And these all, having obtained a good report through faith...

A faith that rests in the wisdom of men will never have the righteousness evidence, because it will be concerned with judging according to appearance. This means that we must learn to live by faith and not by sight (appearance). It is only a faith that rest in the power of God that can have the proof factor.

The faith of God is accessed by an inward witness in a man; a spiritual insight or

understanding that occurs in the hearts that man. So we can say that a faith that rest in the power of God comes with spiritual understanding. And spiritual understanding is a function of the revelation knowledge that comes from God's Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:10,12,15

But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

Your faith lies in your ability to walk in the Spirit, so that your righteousness evidence will always tend to fullfil God's will. Because just the same way God uses men to perform miracles, so also do devil uses fake pastors to perform fake miracles. Note that false witnesses are not

judge according to their testimonies, but according to the fruits of their testimonies. The reason why they brought false witnesses against Jesus, was so that Jesus will be condemned. The safest witness is that which comes from the Spirit. In other words, we must learn to carry the witness of the Spirit in order to be proof producers.

Galatians 5:25

If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

• Law of Righteousness

Romans 8:4

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

The law of righteousness is fulfilled in them

who walk after the Spirit. This means that the place of seeking the influence, leading and instructions of the Spirit is made a priority. This is where sacrifice, fasting and every act of humility is imbibed in order to make sure that a man gains access into the Spirit's domain.

In as much as God desires to dwell in man, man must in turn desire to dwell in the secret place of God. It is here we come to discover the frame work of our personal work with God. So this frame work is in the similitude of walking in the spirit. And it talks about the concept of obedience to the voice of the Spirit.

Romans 8:1-3

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own

Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

Now, since the law of Righteousness is fulfilled by men of the Spirit; And the bible says that; where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty. In this case, we can simply understand that, the law of Righteousness is the law of liberty (which is in similitude to the law of the Spirit).

James 1:25

But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

This law of liberty only applies to those who are intentional. It is effective to the doers that understands the methodology of the Spirit. The methodology of the Spirit is gotten in the place of the hearers; this tends to point to the direction of grace. So that a believer will at no time begin to boast in the works of righteousness. The methodology of the Spirit also reveals the dynamics of faith. That's why

faith comes by hearing (God's word and the testimonies of God's works). The truth about Christianity is that, if you believe in the Spirit of Christ, you must learn to yield to him. Because if you don't, you will end up profitless in the things of the kingdom no matter the magnitude of your works.

Luke 18:10-13

Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican.

The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.

I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.

And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.

The aim of the law of liberty (i.e the law of the

Spirit), is to make the fruits of the Spirit manifest in the life of a believer. Anyone who looks into it, will never become a stumblingblock to others in the faith. The law of the Spirit is what guides our liberty in Christ, so we don't end up worse than unbelievers.

2 Peter 2:19-21

While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

We have come to see the importance of the liberty law. And the only way we can align, since

we have the Holy Spirit is through a conscious application of the mind of the Spirit over our daily affairs. This is where spiritual mindedness comes into play. One of the practical ways to have the mind of the Spirit is through the undiluted word of God; This is one of the simplest ways of get instructions for concentrations and applications of wisdom for life's purposes through the knowledge of the Spirit of God.

When it comes to God's righteousness, you don't need any reason to do things, what you need is a leading. And that is by the Holy Spirit.

• Priority of the Righteous

Hebrews 1:8

But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

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The scepter of the kingdom is a scepter of righteousness. Therefore seeking first the kingdom is the priority of a righteous man. A righteous man understands the construct of how to please God unlike an unbeliever; because a righteous man is of the Spirit of God. The way a Righteous man sees the things of God is different from how the world will see it. The world sees an opportunity to make profit while the man sees an opportunity to win souls.

1 Corinthians 9:16

For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!

To get your priority right, you must get your perspective right. The priority of a righteous man is in spreading the power of righteousness rightly; that is why we see an emphasis on seeking the kingdom's righteousness.

Matthew 6:33

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

This means that, we are authorized to make men understand the righteousness that is of God, through our believe and conduct in Christ.

Evangelism is not about going out to preach. It is about demonstrating Christ before men; witnessing Christ before men. And this demonstration is not just in the gifts but in the fruits. So If you haven't gotten to the point, where you live by what you preach, no matter how much souls you have won, once those souls finds out, all the messages you preached to them from beginning, at that point will become in vain.

The priority of the righteous is the fruits of the Spirit and this comes by being a hearer and a doer of the Word. In this case, this righteous man is not just a preacher but an epistle to many. What will back the establishment of your words in the hearts of men is found in the

power of your epistle. So before you go out for Christ, make sure your life has gone out first for Christ. Just as faith without works is dead, so is not practicing what you preach.

In the place of becoming an epistle, you must understand the construct of the law of liberty, which is in the similitude of spiritual fruits.

Ephesians 5:9

(For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

• The Calling of the Righteous

2 Thessalonians 1:11

Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power:

Every man born of God has the call of God. But it is necessary that we understand the meaning of the call of God. In the time of old the call of God could be described as God choosing a man for a specific purposes. Whether it be kings, priests, prophets, messengers, intercessors or covenant bearers; The call of God will always be an indicator that one's life will be an example to generations.

God has called us, but how we answer differs and determines how our destiny will come to fulfilment.

Samson was reckoned as one of the giants of faith who stood against the philistines. But if we take a brief look at Samson's story, we discover that he didn't end according to God's will. This was because, he didn't directly understand the call of God...; that's why he fell in love with the philistine women, while he was meant to be a judge against the philistines.

Ephesians 1:18

The eyes of your understanding being

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enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

1 Corinthians 7:20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.

Note: When God calls a man He empowers him with what is called a ministry. It is up to a man to discover his ministry. Ministry is the summary of understanding the call of God. It is not about holding mic on a pulpit or becoming a pastor of a church. It is about knowing and following the frame work of God's plans for your life. Apart from the pastoral ministry, there are ministries for leadership, which is expressed in politics (government), different organisations; and also there are ministries in entertainments. This means that there are believers called to show the part of decency in music, drama, art, comedy, and sports, which reflects Christ. Ministry talks about a pattern that is different from the world but has the power to still draw the attention of the world to the revelation of Christ Jesus.

There are people designed with ministries in the education sector, business sector and also marriage (family) institution.

1 Corinthians 1:26

For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called:

The call of God affects all areas of life and that is why when a man finds it, power is given to fulfill it. But the most important thing is remaining in the will of God. You won't complain or agitate when you walk in the understanding of your calling. Your calling is not a burden to you, but may be to others. Another will not have what it takes to maintain the consistency and integrity required for that calling just as you.

2 Timothy 1:9

Who hath saved us and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us i Christ Jesus before the world

began,

- Sanctification of the Righteous

1 Thessalonians 4:4

That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;

Every righteous man is a vessel; a vessel by which God shows His righteousness. As believers, there's a necessity for us to learn the process of sanctification. Because that is what will determine if we would be a vessel unto honour.

2 Timothy 2:20

But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

It doesn't matter what kind of vessel you are; whether it be gold or wood. What matters is which vessel is honorable in the sight of God. A vessel of honor is determined by how much usefulness; how much relevance you create in the kingdom of God. God isn't concerned with what you are but who you are. And who you are talks about your personality. The question is; Does your personality appeal to honor in the sight of God?. Only sanctified men will get to be used effectively by God.

2 Thessalonians 2:13

But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you I to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

The Holyspirit is the person that brings about the sanctification of the righteous; He brings about the personality of honor. Without the Holyspirit it is impossible, to be sanctified before the eyes of God. But before we claim to

have the Spirit of God, it is necessary that we know and understand the sanctification of the Spirit.

Sanctification is the process of purification; making clean; It is one of the aims of a man's concentration. When the Spirit is received, there is a quickening that occurs and that quickening is a function of the presence of the Holy Spirit. Which enables a man set conscious boundaries in order to eliminate the old life. It is through this method that sanctification occurs in the life of a man; But a man has to first yield to the quickening when it occurs. This yielding process is what the bible calls "Obedience to the truth".

1 Peter 1:22

Seeing ye have purified your souls in **obeying the truth** through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

2 Timothy 2:21

If a man therefore purge himself from these, he

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shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.

• Gospel of Righteousness

The Gospel of righteousness talks about the message of righteousness. What message does God's righteousness pass unto men? How do men see God's righteousness.

Note: Man kind was designed to hear and follow; this means that, people are easily susceptible to ideologies. This is why it is easy to copy or be influenced by another's lifestyle.

To transmit a message you must first get the message. And to get the message of righteousness, you must get the picture of righteousness. It is easier to follow when you have a mental picture of an expectation. Jesus said: **Follow me**, and I will make you fishers of

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men. This second sentence defines the first and it is what powers the mental picture...

Philippians 3:9

And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

The message of God's righteousness is simple and it is embedded in the system of our faith works. Faith is the lens we must use in order to fulfill God's righteousness. Though faith without works is dead so also, works without faith is not of God's righteousness.

James 2:17

Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

Every religion has their moral concepts (law), but the workings of Christianity is designed to have none; because through your believe, necessity is laid upon you to be a hearer and a doer. Therefore christianity shouldn't be

classified as a religion, but as a profession of faith. A place where people aren't scared to make their own choices (free will).

Understand that we do not practice righteousness for show but to grow. Righteousness is a function of spiritual growth. This were a man understands that he is an epistle; And his actions will determine the faith of others.

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Faith is what brings the possibility of pleasing God. So if your righteousness is to please men, then it will lack the faith factor and therefore won't have the power to please God.

You must get the gospel of righteousness aright so you won't be entangled in the system of pride, because of the magnitude of your works and self righteousness. By this, we pass

the right message to the people around us.

● The Righteous Watchmen

These are men who operate under the instructions of God's authority. Their responsibility is a function, of the assignment given to them by God. These men have strong spiritual territorial influence, which gains them levels of recognition and respect in the spirit realm.

Ezekiel 33:7

So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and warn them from me.

Watchmen are regarded as special guards, which acts only in the interest of the king. They are the eyes and ears, and in most cases mouth of the king within and outside a territory. The primary objectives of a watchman is to lookout, report, warn, raise alarm and enforce the decrees (LAW) of the king.

Isaiah 21:6

For thus hath the Lord said unto me, Go, set a watchman, let him declare what he seeth.

The Righteous Watchmen are simply men of God, dedicated to the boundaries of their assignment. They do not fall asleep or neglect their duties. So Whenever God wants to move in a system, He seeks and sends the watchman. You must learn to stick to your assignment, until you witness the move of God in that territory. Learn to build the energy required to be a watchman.

Isaiah 62:6

I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace

day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence,

• The Counsel of Righteousness

Proverbs 12:5

The thoughts of the righteous are right: but the counsels of the wicked are deceit.

Psalms 1:1

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

Blessed is a man who has the counsels of righteousness; he will definitely walk in the way and fulfill the purposes of a righteous man.

You can't claim to have the righteousness of God when you are constantly hearing the counsels of unrighteousness (Don't you know

that one becomes what he/she keeps hearing). Do not cover righteousness with unrighteousness, and do not try to cover unrighteousness with righteousness. If you are righteous then remain righteous and stop hanging around the counsels of unrighteousness; with the aim that you want to win them, when they are the once winning you.

Romans 12:21

Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

Proverbs 20:18

Every purpose is established by counsel: and with good advice make war.

Ungodly counsels are dangerous and has the power to derail, alter and change dynamics of a man's heart. This counsels doesn't just come from physical forces, they are birthed and backed by spiritual forces. Forces which intends to manipulate men, in doing and fulfilling the works of unrighteousness. This is why these forces can either subscribe, to

influencing the hearts of men or the heart of an individual. So we see men committing suicides, because of the powerful influence that these forces of darkness has over them.

A Counsel is an information that one hears, gives heed and allows it's influence, in order to get a direction or make a decision in life.

The only way to get the counsel of righteousness; a godly counsel, the right counsel is to identify the God factor within and around you. Don't assume until you confirm. Because it is your will, doesn't make it God's will.

Seeking the counsel of God is like an application for direction. The bible says acknowledge Him and He will direct your path. So what usually misses in the quest of finding the right Counsel, is the power of recognizing divinity over one's affairs.

Luke 7:30

But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

The reason why men find it difficult acknowledging God, is because they lean (depend) on their own understanding; on their own system of righteousness. And so, this shows the level of their trust in God, which is in the similitude of a man without faith.

Judges 18:5

And they said unto him, Ask counsel, we pray thee, of God, that we may know whether our way which we go shall be prosperous.

Acts 20:27

For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God.
